SALVATION

1 **ROMANS 3:10**
As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one.

ROMANS 3:23 **2**
For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God.

3 **ROMANS 5:8**
But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

ROMANS 6:23 **4**
For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

5 **ROMANS 10:9-10**
If you confess with your mouth Jesus is Lord, and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. for with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

ROMANS 10:13 **6**
For Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

1. We are chosen.

John 15:16

You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name, He may give you.

1 Peter 2:9

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light.

Deuteronomy 7:6

For you are holy people to the Lord your God; the Lord your God has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples on the face of the earth.

2. We are children of the most high God and heirs.

Romans 8:14

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear, but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: and if children of God, then heirs; heirs of God, and jointheirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together.

Galatians 3: 29

And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs of God through Christ.

Galatians 4:7

Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Titus 3: 7

That having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Acts 2: 38

Then Peter said unto them, repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

3. We are light.

Ephesians 5:8-9

For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light. (for the fruit of the Spirit is all goodness, righteousness, and truth),

Matthew 5: 14-16

Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see you good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

4. We are saints.

Colossians 1: 12

giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light.

Ephesians 5: 3

But fornication (sexual immorality) and all uncleanness, or covetousness (greed), let it not even be named among you, as is fitting for saints; neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting (crude joking), which are not convenient, but rather giving thanks.

5. We have authority of Jesus Christ.

Luke 10: 19

Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Matthew 28: 18-20

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Mark 16:17-18

And these signs shall follow them that believe; in My name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

6. We are a member of God's household.

Ephesians 2: 19

Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God.

7. We have the righteousness of Christ.

2 Corinthians 5: 21

For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

1 Corinthians 1: 30

But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God – and righteousness and sanctification and redemption

Romans 10: 4

For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

8. We are a dwelling place for the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 3: 16

Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

Romans 8: 11

But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

Ephesians 1: 13-14

In Him you also trusted after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory.

9. We are holy.

Leviticus 20: 26

And ye shall be holy unto me: for I the Lord am holy, and have set you apart from other people, that ye should be mine.

Deuteronomy 7: 6

For you are a holy people to the Lord your God; the Lord your God has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples on the earth.

10. We are kings and priests.

Revelation 1: 5-6

And from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

11. We are overcomers and more than conquerors through Jesus Christ.

Revelation 3: 21

To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.

1 John 5:4

For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world – our faith.

1 John 4: 4

You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

Revelation 21: 7

He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son.
