

Mark 16:16





# One of God's great servants (Generals)

John G. Lake

(1870-1935) 65y



#### Why a great servant?

- 1. He started with preaching and soon he had a preaching and healing ministry.
- 2. He had several gifts of the Holy Spirit.
- 3. The Lord labored powerfull and very often through him.
- 4. He was a preacher and had large audiences.
- 5. He planted new churches.
- 6. He communicated often with the Lord.
- 7 He got his instructions from the Lord.
- 8. He was persecuted, lied to and betrayed, slandered, but also honored, adored and supported because of his preaching, healings and deliverances.
- 9. Hundreds of thousands of people got saved by the gospel preached by him.
- 10. Hundreds of thousands of people got healed, delivered and saved by Jesus through the Holy Spirit in him.
- 11. He travelled to other countries to share the gospel.

## John G. Lake

- a. Born in Canada in 1870. He died in 1935. While still a child he moved to the US.
- b. He was first a successful business man.
- c. He believed that sicknesses are not of God. God has sent Jesus also to heal the sick.

He refers to Lucas 4: 18

Jesus is saying:

18. The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; He hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised.

### d. That the church is given the gifts of the Holy Spirit, 1 Cor 12: 8-10

- 8. For the one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit.
- 9. To another faith by the same Spirit; to another prophesy; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit.
- 10. To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues.

#### for the church to practice these gifts, James 5: 13-16

- 13. Is any among you afflicted? Let him pray. Is any merry? Let him sing psalms.
- 14. Is any sick among you? Let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.
- 15. And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he has committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.
- 16. Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

- e. John Lake is thought to have had the greatest healing ministry in the Modern age. He raised several people from the dead, cast out demons and ministered healing to people with cancer, missing eyes and every kind of disorder.
- f. Lake heard the call of God and sold everything and moved with his wife and seven children to South Africa, where he served as a missionary for several years.
- g. He studied Divine Healing under Alexander Dowie in his city Zion.
- h. After he returned to the US, Lake started Healing rooms in Spokane, Washington and Portland and Oregon, where over 100.000 people were documented to have been healed.

- i. He believed in the baptism of the Holy Spirit, John 1: 33.
  - 33. And I knew Him not: He that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on Him, the same is He which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.
  - He believed in order to get the baptism of the Holy Spirit, one must come in definite conscious contact with Jesus Christ himself.
- j. He had experiences during praying being transported in the spirit to other countries. (To Wales when he was in Johannesburg, to Johannesburg when he was in Iowa)

### How it all began for John. G. Lake

He lost 8 siblings out of 16 and almost lost his first wife in that period too.

His first wife was very sick and was healed by prayer by John Alexander Dowie, after John Lake sent him a telegram for help.

This ignited a fire in John Lake, he would not tolerate any longer let the enemy steal his loved ones from him.

He determined to believe God's Word as revealed to him for healing.

So his ministries for the Lord started.

# Remarkable expressions or characteristics of John G. Lake

- His spiritual travellings. (as Paul who went to the seventh heaven)
- His healing rooms. More than 100.000 registered people were healed.
- "The ministry of Christianity is the ministry of the Spirit".
- Before his published Newsletter was sent all over the world to thousands of people, his church members would lay hands on them and pray that the Newsletter would filled with God's Spirit and the Newsletters had the same effect as the handkerchiefs in the days of Apostle Paul: miracles, wonders and baptism with the Holy Spirit.
