

Who Saw Jesus After His Resurrection (with Bible References)

1. Mary Magdalene

- John 20:14-17

- Jesus first appeared to Mary, who recognized Him when He spoke her name.

2. Several women

- Matthew 28:9-10

- Jesus greeted them on their way back from the tomb.

3. Two disciples on the road to Emmaus

- Luke 24:13-35

- They recognized Him when He broke the bread.

4. Peter (Simon)

- Luke 24:34, 1 Corinthians 15:5

- A personal encounter, few details are given.

5. The eleven disciples without Thomas

- John 20:19-23, Luke 24:36-49

- Jesus appeared in a locked room.

6. The eleven disciples with Thomas present

- John 20:26-29

- Thomas touched Jesus' wounds.

7. Seven disciples at the Sea of Galilee

- John 21:1-14
- Peter jumped into the water to meet Jesus.

8. More than 500 brothers at once

- 1 Corinthians 15:6
- Paul testifies to this mass appearance.

9. James (the brother of Jesus)

- 1 Corinthians 15:7
- A personal encounter.

10. The disciples at the Ascension

- Luke 24:50-53, Acts 1:3-12
- Jesus blessed them and was taken up into heaven.

During 40 days, Jesus appeared multiple times in His glorified body to His followers.

How many times in total?

- At least 10 separate occasions are mentioned in the New Testament.
- Sometimes to individuals, sometimes to small groups, sometimes to a large group of 500 people.
- He appeared over a period of 40 days after His resurrection (Acts 1:3).
